The LSCC autocross will be held on the third Saturday of each month beginning in March and ending in November.

We will be holding our events at Brookhaven College. Brookhaven is located at 3939 Valley View Lane (Valley View Lane and Alpha Road) in Farmers Branch. We will be racing on parking lot P2. P2 is concrete rather than asphalt. This is the link of the Brookhaven campus map.

Setup will begin at 8:30 am. For those helping with set up, be there at 8:30 am. The more help we have the quicker we get to start. Drivers should be there no later than 9:00 am to register and sign waivers. We begin racing at 9:30 am.

spend!



On July 2, the National Corvette Museum E-news published the final stats on 2015 Corvette production. 34,240 Corvettes were produced, slightly lower than last year's 37,288.

The breakdown is:
