Kai Spande, NCM Board member who also happens to be Corvette Assembly Plant Manager, donated his weekend to the Classic. Kai's flight here was cancelled, so he drove from Bowling Green to be with us. The drive was not too bad, as he made it in a 2018 Z06. Kai spent Friday and Saturday visiting with many, many Classic attendees. Then, Saturday evening he delivered a great, humor filled presentation on changes at the assembly plant and Whoop Ass Beer (you had to be there).

Finally, Lon Helton, NCM Board Member, and his wife Anne had hoped to attend the Classic. They were unable to make it, but sent LSCC a guitar signed by the Who's Who of country music. It fetched an amazing \$4,000 for the Classic's beneficiaries.

Important 2018 Corvette production Dates

This information is on our club's website, but I will repeat it here, in case you missed it.

- Begins June 5th.
- · Ceases temporarily July 28th.
- Last day to order car for build before July 28th is July 12th.
- Plant will be closed 13 weeks for assembly line renovation.
- Plant tours will cease June 16 for 12 to 18 months.

The 2018 Corvette model year will end on Friday, June 2nd. 2018 Corvette production starts up on the following Monday, June 5.

'Assembly plant tours will cease June 16th. Production of the 2018 Corvettes will continue through June and July and will come to a stop on July 28th.

The Bowling Green assembly plant closes for three months as upgrades to the plant are performed. The plant's closure is expected to run August, September, and October, 2018. Corvette production will resume from where it left off on November 1st.

GM Supplier Discount Update

Last month I reported about the introduction on GM Supplier Discounts for NCM members. At the Classic, I spoke with Chad Brownlow, a member of the Wichita County Corvette Association. Speeds in Autocross are slower, in absolute terms, when compared to other forms of racing but the activity level, measured in discrete turns per minute, can be higher than even Formula One due to the large number of elements packed into each course. The donation is \$15 per car. Helmets are required but loaners are available.

Open Road Racers, Sandhills Open Road Challenge is a 55-mile rally style open road race through the scenic Nebraska Sandhills on August 9th - 12th. Arguably the most demanding event of its kind in America, the SORC offers a daunting series of "S" curves, straights, and 90-degree turns to challenge the most talented of drivers. NCM Motorsports Park HPDE Track Day June 5th & 6th



The National Corvette Museum embarked on one of the most exciting and significant expansion projects in the nearly 20-year history of the Museum when, on June 28, 2013, it broke ground on a 184 acre Motorsports Park. The \$20 million, dual-track attraction provides motorsports enthusiasts with a new favorite destination. The two circuits, "East" and "West" can be combined into multiple configurations ranging from a high speed loop of 1.96 miles to an extended 3.15 mile technical course. The teams at Corvette Racing and Pratt and Miller advised the Museum on the layout, incorporating features from their most challenging track, the Le Mans circuit. The facility welcomes all makes and models of vehicles, including motorcycles.



LSCC was instrumental in donating land during the construction of the NCM Motorsports Park and earned several private track days in the process. So, we will be traveling to Bowling Green to "cash-in" on two of those days. We will have the entire park to ourselves! Imagine traveling to Disney World and having free run of the Park. It's kind of like that, but only better.

Kristina and I have been LSCC members for nearly 10 years and I think this will be our 8th year attending this event.. so we obviously have enjoyed it, as have many others who've been going much longer than we have! If you have never been on a LSCC caravan, I would like to reach out and invite you to a super fun trip this October. After all, who does not like to drive the best car made, on some of the most beautiful roads in America, enjoying friends during a nice meal while sharing in a well-run, activity-filled weekend with other Corvette enthusiasts. If this has a spark of interest, well, all you need to do is sign up on the LSCC website and save the date. We will communicate the trip details down the line via email.

As usual, we will have two departure dates. The shortest, most direct route leaves on Thursday, October 5th, and is mostly on divided highways and typically includes the scenic Pig Trail Byway through the Boston Mountains.

For those who have an extra day and want to experience some additional beauty, curvy roads and desire a little culture, we will leave on Wednesday, October 4th. This caravan will gather and leave from the Oklahoma Welcome Center and head to Broken Bow where we will stop for lunch. After lunch, we will head north thru Ouachita National Forest to our hotel in Rogers, AR. After a restful night, we will head to Bentonville to visit the Walmart Museum and Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art. A sit down lunch is being planned at the Eleven Restaurant in the Crystal Bridges Museum. 
