The Lone Star Corvette Club is dedicated to the Corvette lifestyle and the people that own them.

Our Club slogan says it all:

Founded in 1982, the Club now has over 1,000 members – each with his/her own story to tell of how they found that perfect "Vette." Based in the Dallas – Fort Worth Metroplex, it offers just about any activity an owner of "America's Sports Car" could want: Road Trips, Day Trips, Open Road Racing, DragRacing, Autocross, NCRS (National Corvette Restorers Society), Car Shows, Displays and Parades, the Lone Star Corvette Classic, Club Meetings, and most of all, fun times with good friends.

Road Trips – Want to explore the wide open road? The Club takes at least one significant road trip each year, usually in conjunction with a Corvette event. A large group recently returned from a caravan to Eureka Springs, Arkansas, winning the club participation event at the show. Past trips have taken us to the Upper Pennisula of Michigan, the Barrett Jackson Auction in Scottsdale, Arizona, the National Corvette Museum's 15th Anniversary Caravan to Bowling Green, Kentucky, and many more.

Day Trips – Want to enjoy North Texas? Just about every month finds a group of us headed somewhere in our Corvettes for a day of fun on the road. It might be for a tour of some local wineries, a trip to the Historic Fort Worth Stockyards for a cattle drive and BBQ, a car show being held by another Corvette club, a tour of members' garages, or just a drive in the country to enjoy our cars and each other's company.

Open Road Racing – Like to go fast in your Vette? Many Club members participate in Open Road Racing at events held in Big Bend, Texas and Arnold, Nebraska. In addition, several driving schools are offered in the DFW area where you can go to hone your driving skills. For more information, just "click" on "Open Road Racing".

Drag Racing – Want to "go fast"? Join the club Drag Racers. They compete at tracks around the Metroplexfor trophies and bragging rights. Many members –both ladies and men – race cars (pickups too) in addition to Corvettes. No experience is required. For more information, just "click" on "<u>Drag Racing</u>".

Autocross – Want to sharpen your driving skills? Try autocross! An autocross is a timed competition where drivers navigate, one at a time, through a temporary course marked by traffic cones, usually in a parking lot. Autocross places more emphasis on car handling and driving skill than on sheer horsepower. For more information, just "click" on "Autocross".

NCRS – Want your older model corvette to be an accurate icon? Many Club members also belong to the NCRS – National Corvette Restorers Society. If you are into originality and the preservation of the Corvette as an icon, you will find many in the Club that share your passion. For more information, just "click" on "NCRS".

Car Shows – Love showing your Vette off or having it judged? On almost any weekend (except for a few in the winter), at least one group from the Club will be headed to either a local or an out-of-town car show. We usually caravan to the out-of-town shows as a group and use the trip as a good excuse to socialize and dine out together. The Club sponsors a group of members each year in the Dallas Autorama. On the first Saturday of each month, you'll find a bunch of us at Cars & Coffee in Plano, "kicking tires" and telling tall tales about our cars.

Displays and Parades – Looking to share the Corvetter spirit? Every year we man a display of our cars in the Dallas New Car Show at the Convention Center. We also take a large contingent of Vettes to the State Fair of Texas. We've been asked in the past to drive Indy Car drivers around the Texas Motor Speedway's oval before races. Christmas finds us backing up the bikers in the Great Texas Toy Run that benefits thousands of needy children in the area. The Dallas Veterans' Day Parade has come to rely on the Club to provide cars and drivers for over 100 WWII Veterans each year. Ask any Club member who has participated and you will be told what an honor it is.

Lone Star Corvette Classic – In May of each year, the premier Corvette event in Texas is held at the Texas Motor Speedway by the Club. During its three day run, the "Classic" attracts hundreds of Corvettes and Corvette Club members from across the US and Canada. In addition, Corvette enthusiasts from around the area attend the event to take advantage of many different activities, including judged and Show N Shine indoor car shows, a variety of automotive vendors, good food, and exciting track events held on the Texas Motor Speedway's oval and road course. 100% of the net proceeds from the Classic go to support the Club's two main charities, The National Corvette Museum and Speedway Children's Charities, and a third charity chosen from several candidates each year by Club members.

Club Meetings – We want you! The Club meets on the second Saturday of each month at various locations around the Metroplex. We would love to have you come to a meeting and "check us out."

Louis to LeMans

If the One Lap of Kentucky MiM does not work out for you, consider your own LSCC Member in Motion tour of Kentucky this fall.

Start, of course, at the National Corvette Museum to see the latest featured exhibit "Louis to LeMans".

The Museum's Exhibit Hall has once again been trans-

formed to feature a special themed display. For a period of about seven months, that theme focuses on Chevrolet racing history. The story of Chevrolet racing is told from the early days of Louis Chevrolet as a racing driver for Buick, through the AMA ban on racing, to Chevrolet Racing's involvement in NASCAR, and the Le Mans winning Corvettes. Significant stories are told through the display of various cars and artifacts, from engines including one from a C5-R, and a fuel injection cutaway, to race suits and more. The exhibit will run until January 4, 2019.

From the Museum you can head any direction and find outstanding attractions.

The Museum has written tour routes turn by turn instructions for many attractions within 100 miles of the NCM. These are free for the asking.

Speeds in *Autocross* are slower, in absolute terms, when compared to other forms of racing but the activity level, measured in turns per minute, can be higher than even Formula One due to the large number of elements that are packed into each course. The requested donation is **\$15 per car**. Helmets are required and loaners are available.

Drag Racing is on summer break for now. Next event will be Sunday, Sept 9th at Wichita Raceway Park - Iowa Park (Wichita Falls). Please contact Martha Kaus if you have any questions.

Open Road Racers, Next event is the Silver State Classic Challenge on September 13-16th. State Route #318 between Lund and Hiko, Nevada is closed for the running of this unique event. The race covers 90 miles of fenced, two lane highway with long straights, twisty sections and dips. 





Darker colors need additional protection from chips so XPel Paint Protection Film for the full bumper, headlights, mirrors, door cups and even the door sills to protect from scuffing (the C7 is known for this). 
